#### **CLARIFICATIONS FOR FILLING THE API FORM (CATEGORY – III):**

- 1. Score for paper in refereed journal would be augmented as follows:
  - (i) Indexed Journals 5 points
  - (ii) Paper with impact factor between 1 and 2 10 Points
  - (iii) Paper with impact factor between 2 and 5 15 points
  - (iv) Paper with impact factor between 5 and 10 25 points
- 2. If a paper presented in Conference/Seminar is published in the form of proceedings the point would accrue for the publication (III)(A)(ii) and not under presentation (III)(E)(ii).
- 3. The API for joint publications will have to be calculated in the following manner: Of the total score for the relevant category of publications by the concern teacher the first / principal author and the corresponding author / supervisor / mentor of the teacher would share equally total score. If the number of authors are more that the first two authors would share equally 60% of the total points and remaining authors would share equally 40% of the points.
