

ABOUT ANNAMALAI UNIVERSITY

In the early 1920s Rajah Sir S.R.M.AnnamalaiChettiar found Sri Minakshi College, Sri Minakshi Tamil College and Sri Minakshi Sanskrit College at Chidambaram, In1928, Rajah Sir S.R.M.AnnamalaiChettiar agreed with the local Government to handover the above said institution for establishing a University.
